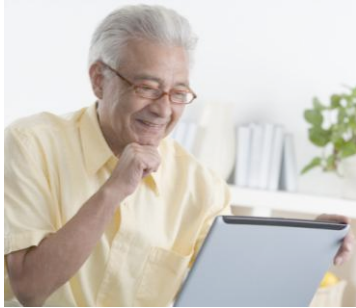


# *Volunteer at The Denis Theatre Foundation*

## *Committee Work*
